- > Have a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (or the equivalent) from a bachelor's or master's degree or have a minimum GPA of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale (or the equivalent) from a bachelor's degree, in combination with two years of full-time work experience
- > Be a current NSHMBA member
- > Be enrolled in an AACSB accredited graduate business program in the United States or Puerto Rico at the time of the award
